Parents: Please make note of the times and sessions that you have registered your child in. You will not be contacted to confirm registration. You will only be contacted if the class that you have requested if full. All lessons will be held at the Elkin Municipal Pool at 399 HWY 268 West, Elkin NC 28621.

The Elkin Recreation & Parks Department uses the American Red Cross 'Learn to Swim' Program as a model for its swim lessons program. The program consists of three (3) levels through which children advance at their own pace based upon demonstration of the appropriate skills. The three (3) levels are:

- Level 1 Water Exploration: Orient to aquatic environment; create a sound foundation for aquatic and safety skills.
- Level 2 Primary Skills: Expand on fundamental aquatic locomotion and safety skills
- Level 3 Stroke Readiness: Increase swimming skill competency; practice safety and non-swimming rescue skills.

Please carefully review your personal schedule when making your time and session selection. Because of the large number of requests, we are not able to move or transfer registration.

Refund Policy: Refunds shall only be made when requested at least one week prior to the start of the session that you originally registered. The request must be made in writing to the Pool Manager and a \$5.00 administrative fee will be deducted from all refunds.

If you or your swimmer is sick or exhibiting symptoms of Covid19, please do not attend swim lessons.

Cancellation Policy: For information on cancellations, please call (336) 835-4747. Each session will be Monday-Thursday for two (2) weeks. For the safety of your child we will not have class if staff witness thunder or lightning and classes may be cancelled at any time. We may have lessons in a light rain if no threat of severe weather is present. If a class is cancelled due to inclement weather or Swim Team Meet, the class will be re-scheduled to the following Friday. If multiple classes are missed then classes may be made up the following Monday of the two-week session.

IMPORTANT: You may want to bring a lawn chair, as the instructors will request that all parents remain outside of the pool fence during the swim lesson instructional time. There will be time during each session that parents will be invited to come into the pool area to observe their child. The instructors make this request because our past experience has shown that children are able to devote more of their attention to the instructor when the parent is not nearby.
