



Demographic Analysis & Existing Conditions

- Typical census data
 - Age, Race, Poverty, Population
- Mapped Recreation
 Center service area
- Field site analysis of park assets
 - Ranking of facilities and natural areas
 - Opportunity identification

- 3 Public Workshops
 - Open house style, with interactive feedback stations
- 5 Focus groups
 - Staff, coaches, health professionals, volunteers and older adults
- Presentation to school groups

Survey Highlights


- 251 survey responses
- 54% of respondents live in Elkin
- FACILITY USE
 - Elkin Municipal Park is used daily or weekly by 56% of respondents



Survey Highlights

FACILITIES

- O Desired Recreation Center Improvements:
 - × Aquatics facility
 - Restrooms accessible from outside
 - Larger fitness room (Gym floor # 3 for region)
- o To Add:
 - **x** Indoor Aquatics
 - **Expand Greenway**
- TRAILS
 - Connect to downtown
 - Address safety issues



Survey Highlights

• FINANCIAL

- 72% of Elkin residents in support of new financial methods to fund parks and recreation (26% undecided)
- Bond referendum and Annual Household fee are top two choices


OTHER

- Music events at municipal park reported as top special event
- Personal fitness training is recommended new program
- 72% of Elkin respondents have lived here more than 10 years or all their life



Greenway Plan

- Alternatives for connecting Municipal and Crater Park
- Some conceptual routes
- EVTA provided significant feedback and direction
 - Mountain bike trail system layout
 - Trail alignment in implementation north of Municipal Park
- Plan includes 3 different trail maps

- Proposed improvements
 - Rec Center Outside
 Improvements (Restrooms, patio and porch)
 - New Parking
 - New Picnic Shelters 2x
 - New/Moved Bandstand
 - Outdoor pool enhancements
 - Ball field lighting improvements
 - Update restrooms and concessions

Plan Recommendations – Mid Term 6-10 Yr



Existing Facilities

- · Crater Park improvements (see Figure 18)
- · Improve bathroom and concessions, install covered porch at Municipal pool
- · Add two picnic shelters at Municipal Park

New Facilities

- Extend MST along Yadkin River and connect with Surry County's Fisher River park
- · Amphitheatre for music and other events

Programs

- Expand programs and special event based on community interest
- Engage local bicycle club to continue to advocate for on-road bicycling improvements to improve access to parks and trail facilities

Administration

- Develop formal funding partnership with the Elkin City Schools and other recreation partners for future existing and facility needs
- · Update Recreation, Parks and Greenway Master Plan

\$1.4M

Plan Recommendations – Long Term 11-20 Yr



Recommendations

- Add spray park to Municipal Park pool
- Remove old water plant
- Acquire land closer to I-77 for future recreation needs
- Construct indoor aquatics facility in partnership with Elkin City Schools or other partners
- Update Recreation, Parks and Greenway
 Plan
- Update programming and events based on demand, need and interest

Plan Outcomes

- Site specific plans for priority facilities & programs
- Strategy for implementation plan over the next 10 years
- Pursue Strategic Partnerships
 - Strongly encouraged from funders both public and private
- Plans required for grants
 - o PARTF
 - Recreational Trails Program
 - O NCDOT
